Dear valued customer,

Over the years we at Atmosphere Air Conditioning have seen firsthand the damage that can be caused to the external unit of an air conditioner due to corrosion and what it can cost to repair or replace these units. We are currently receiving an increasing amount of call outs (repairs) for air conditioning units that are reported not to be working as efficiently and a lot of the time we are finding this is due to the corrosion of parts or the outdoor air conditioning unit itself. Working on rusted/corroded units can be quite difficult and dangerous and often replacement is the best option.

Cases like these are quite common in houses located in towns on the coast such as Nelson Bay, Shoal Bay etc. This can be found anywhere though. To help combat this issue we have introduced an anti-corrosion spray as an optional extra when having your air conditioner installed. This spray is

completely transparent and does not alter the unit's appearance in any major way. For new installations the application takes place here in the workshop before the installation date to make the process as quick and easy as possible. This can also be applied to units that have been installed already and are not already extensively damaged by rust/corrosion.

This multi-year spray not only protects the external cover of the outdoor unit, but the covers are removed, and the internal part of the outdoor unit is sprayed including the compressor, PCB's and all other internal elements of the unit to offer some extra rust/corrosion protection. Not only does this spray protect the unit from corrosion but it also helps to decrease the spread of mould and prevents pc boards blowing due to insect/amphibians



entering the system that may carry any moisture onto the board, as rodent damage is not covered under warranty this is a great option. The manufacturers recommend that this spray is applied every two years to ensure you are getting maximum protection for your unit, this can be done at the same time as your scheduled servicing.

Please note although this spray does help with preventing rust/corrosion from forming, we advise that you avoid placing things on top of your air conditioning unit or letting any plants grow up onto or around your air conditioner as this can definitely speed up the rusting/corroding process.
